# 2023 - 2024 Accomplishments

- **Formal Education Initiatives:** Continued to work with medical education stakeholders to support and expand program capacity to address need for more medical dosimetrists in the workforce.
- **AAMD Curriculum Guidelines:** Formal Education Committee has updated the Curriculum Guidelines and received JRCERT approval.
- **Virtual Member Meet-ups:** Hosted two (2) member events and for members to share clinical experiences and insights.
- ***Medical Dosimetry Journal:*** Completed transition to electronic-only publishing

# 2023 - 2024 Accomplishments

- **AAMD Salary Survey:** Collected key salary and workforce data for 2023. Full report will be published in July.
- **Industry Collaboration:** Continued to work with sister radiation oncology organizations (ASTRO, ASRT, AAPM, SROA, MDCB, JRCERT) to address important issues for medical dosimetrists
  - **ROCR:** Continued to monitor developments via ASTRO working group
  - **Consensus Committee Meeting:** Participated in ASRT/ARRT/JRCERT meeting to outline workforce strategies for radiation therapy and medical imaging professions
  - **ASTRO Workforce Article:** Wrote medical dosimetry workforce article (to be published July 2024)
  - **RO-ILS:** Continued financial support of the Radiation Oncology Incident Learning System.

# AAMD Education Grants Awarded

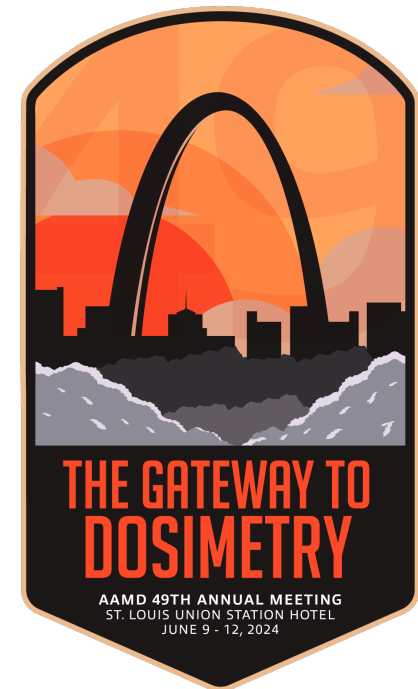
