2022 - 2023 Accomplishments

- **Formal Education Initiatives:** Continued to work with medical education stakeholders to support and expand program capacity to address need for more medical dosimetrists in the workforce.
- **Virtual Member Meet-ups:** Hosted 3 regional member events and 1 international event for members to share clinical experiences and insights.
- **Virtual Student Forums:** Hosted 2 online forums for medical dosimetry students: *Tips & Tricks for Planning Advanced Breast & Chest Wall Cancers* and *Proton Dosimetry 101*.

2022 - 2023 Accomplishments

- **AAMD Scope of Practice/Practice Standards:** Formed an interdisciplinary task group to update the AAMD Scope of Practice and Practice Standards that were published in May 2023.
- **Industry Collaboration:** Continued to work with sister radiation oncology organizations (ASTRO, ASRT, AAPM, SROA, MDCB, JRCERT) to address important issues for medical dosimetrists
 - **RO-APM:** Continued to monitor developments via industry working group through rule-making process.
 - **AAMD/ASRT Task Group:** Completed a framework for the alignment of the ASRT and AAMD Medical Dosimetry Practice Standards
 - **RO-ILS:** Continued financial support of the Radiation Oncology Incident Learning System.

2022 - 2023 Accomplishments

- **Legion Healthcare Partners Collaboration:** Continued work with Legion to offer specialized proton therapy planning education for medical dosimetrists.
- **International Outreach:** Worked with professional societies in Brazil, Southeast Asia and Australia to develop and promote educational opportunities for treatment planning professionals.
- **RAD-AID:** Sponsored first AAMD medical dosimetrist to travel to Kenya with RAD-AID.
- **Social Media:** Continued to grow AAMD Instagram, Facebook, LinkedIn and Twitter communities to include more than 8,000 worldwide followers

AAMD Financial Overview

September 30, 2022

The AAMD did not post a positive financial gain for FY22:

- Hosted first in-person Annual Meeting in 2022 after the pandemic
- Increased expenses due to inflation
- Lower investment portfolio returns
- Board Action:
 - Review contracts and streamlined expenditures
 - Followed AAMD Financial Policies and Procedures and FY22 Budget
- Consistent membership numbers
 - 3,254 members in 2021 vs. 3,281 members in 2022
 - Dues have not increased since 2009

AAMD Meeting Expenses – Did You Know?

- Registration Fees vs. Actual Meeting Costs
 - Based on preliminary costs: **\$675 vs. \$707**
 - Costs quickly outpacing registration fees
- Increased Hotel and Meeting-related Costs – *Need for cost control*
 - Coffee: **\$12.50/cup**
 - Bagel: **\$8.50 each**
 - AV - **\$165/attendee** (\$90,000 est. total cost)
