



## COVID-19 Health and Safety Policies

Please be advised that a risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any event or public space, including the AAMD 47<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting. AAMD understands it's challenging to consider attending an in-person meeting at this time. However, we want attendees to be informed about the health and safety measures being put in place by AAMD.

- The AAMD will follow guidelines for COVID-19 safety for meetings and events as published by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), State of Maryland, City of Baltimore, and the Hilton Baltimore Inner Harbor.
- Protective face masks will be required in all meeting spaces during the event.
- While proof of vaccination isn't required to attend the meeting, the AAMD recommends vaccination and a negative COVID-19 test prior to arrival onsite for the meeting.
- Attendees may be required to complete daily health checks via a mobile app.

**Note:** These policies are subject to change based on current state, local and CDC guidelines at the time of the event. AAMD may adjust the policies to be in compliance with guidelines in effect at the time of the meeting. By attending the AAMD 47<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting, attendees acknowledge and confirm they will comply in full with each of the following applicable health and safety guidelines:

- That you will wear a protective mask at all times during the Annual Meeting, except when actively eating or drinking, or when speaking from a lectern that's at least 6' from others;
- That you will abide by all health-and-safety protocols of Centers of Disease Control (CDC), State of Maryland, City of Baltimore and the Hilton Baltimore Inner Harbor.
- That you are not currently experiencing any of the following symptoms of COVID-19: fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, or diarrhea;
- That, prior to attending the AAMD 47<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting, you have not been in contact with someone with confirmed or suspected COVID-19 symptoms without completing a 5-day quarantine; and
- That you are not under any self-quarantine orders.
